# ACUPUNCTURE LICENSING ACT AMENDMENTS

Representative **Stewart E. Barlow** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 33 through 46:*

- 33           (2) (a) "Injection therapy" means the use of a hypodermic needle , by a licensed acupuncturist who  
34 has the training described in Subsection 58-72-701(1), to inject any of the  
35 following sterile substances in liquid form into acupuncture points on a person subcutaneously  
36 or intramuscularly:  
37           (i) a nutritional substance;  
38           (ii) a local anesthetic;  
39           (iii) autologous blood obtained by cupping or scraping;  
40           (iv) sterile water;  
41           (v) sterile water with dextrose; and  
42           (vi) sterile saline.  
43           (b) "Injection therapy" includes using ultrasound guidance to ensure that an injection is  
44 only a subcutaneous injection or an intramuscular injection.  
45           (c) "Injection therapy" does not include injecting :  
46           (i) a substance into a vein, joint, artery,  
47 blood vessel, nerve, tendon, deep organ, or the spine of a person { } ; or  
48 (ii) a local anesthetic into a person who is pregnant or who is under the age of 12.  
49           [~~(2)~~] (3) "Licensed acupuncturist," designated as "L.Ac.," means a person who has
