Senator **Gene Davis** proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 54 through 56:
 - 54 (1) <u>subject to Subsection (3)</u>, for standards and guidelines pertaining to plaster on a historic property, as defined
 - 55 in Section 9-8-302, the U.S. Department of the Interior Secretary's Standards for Rehabilitation
 - 56 and Guidelines for Rehabilitating Historic Buildings.
- 2. Page 2, Line 57 through Page 3, Line 62:
 - 57 (2) Consistent with Title 65A, Chapter 8, Management of Forest Lands and Fire
 - 58 Control, the Legislature adopts the 2006 edition of the Utah Wildland Urban Interface Code,
 - 59 issued by the International Code Council, with the alternatives or amendments approved by the
 - 60 Utah Division of Forestry, as a construction code that may be adopted by a local compliance
 - 61 agency by local ordinance or other similar action as a local amendment to the codes listed in
 - 62 this section.
 - (3) The standards and guidelines described in Subsection (1)(1) apply only if:
 - (a) the owner of the historic property receives a government tax subsidy based on the property's status as a historic property;
 - (b) the historic property is wholly or partially funded by public money; or
 - (c) the historic property is owned by a government entity.
