Representative Carl R. Albrecht proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 51 through 55:
 - 51 (2) (a) "Crossing" means a telecommunications facility constructed { over, } under, or
 - 52 <u>across a railroad right-of-way:</u>
 - (i) at an angle between 80 degrees and 100 degrees;
 - 54 (ii) with a minimum depth of 10 feet below rail level; and
 - 55 (iii) within a county that is not a county of the first class.
- 2. Page 3, Lines 65 through 67:
 - (b) A request under this Subsection (1) shall:
 - 66 (i) be in the <u>railroad</u> form of a completed crossing application;
 - (ii) include an engineering design that:
- 3. *Page 3, Lines 70 through 76:*
 - 70 (B) conforms with guidelines published in the most recent edition of the National
 - 71 <u>Electric Safety Code</u> <u>and American Railway Engineering and Maintenance-of-Way Association</u> <u>standards</u>; and
 - 72 (iii) include the standard crossing fee specified in Section 54-23-105.
 - 73 (2) Unless the railroad provides written or electronic notice to the that the
 - 74 proposed crossing is a serious threat to the safe operations of the railroad or to the current or future use
 - 75 of the railroad right-of-way, the railroad shall approve the application within 35 calendar days
 - after the receipt of a completed application for a crossing.
- 4. Page 4, Lines 88 through 90:
 - 88 approved crossing is a serious threat to the safe operation of the railroad or to the current or future use of
 - 89 <u>the railroad right-of-way, the railroad shall issue the</u> {<u>contractor's right of entry</u>} <u>permit</u> and schedule
 - 90 flagging to occur within 45 calendar days of the approved application.
- 5. Page 5, Lines 119 through 122:
 - (1) If a railroad objects to the proposed crossing due to the proposal being a serious

- 120 threat to the safe operations of the railroad or to the current or future use of the railroad right-of-way, the
- railroad shall provide written or electronic notice to the fiber optic carrier of the objection and
- the specific basis for the objection.
