

150 (C) improper use of school property, including a parking violation;  
 151 (ii) a payment for school breakfast or lunch;  
 152 (iii) a deposit that is:  
 153 (A) a pledge securing the return of school property; and  
 154 (B) refunded upon the return of the school property; or  
 155 (iv) a charge for insurance, unless the insurance is required for a student to participate  
 156 in an activity, course, or program.

157 (7) (a) "Fundraising" means an activity or event provided, sponsored, or supported by  
 158 an LEA that uses students to generate funds or raise money to:

159 (i) provide financial support to a school or a school's class, group, team, or program; or  
 160 (ii) benefit a particular charity or for other charitable purposes.

161 (b) "Fundraising" does not include an alternative method of raising revenue without  
 162 students.

163 (8) (a) "School activity clothing" means special shoes or items of clothing:

164 (i) (A) that meet specific requirements, including requesting a specific ~~H~~→ [color, style]

164a **brand** ←~~H~~ ,

165 fabric, or imprint; and

166 (B) that a school requires a student to provide; and

167 (ii) that is worn by a student for a co-curricular or extracurricular activity.

168 (b) "School activity clothing" does not include ~~H~~→ :

168a **(i)** ←~~H~~ a school uniform ~~H~~→ [-] ; **or**

168b **(ii) clothing that is commonly found in students' homes.** ←~~H~~

169 (9) (a) "School uniform" means special shoes or an item of clothing:

170 (i) (A) that meet specific requirements, including a requested specific color, style,

171 fabric, or imprint; and

172 (B) that a school requires a student to provide; and

173 (ii) that is worn by a student for a curricular activity.

174 (b) "School uniform" does not include school activity clothing.

175 (10) "Secondary school" means a school that provides instruction to students in grades

176 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, or 12.

177 (11) "Secondary school student":

178 (a) means a student enrolled in a secondary school; and

179 (b) includes a student in grade 6 if the student attends a secondary school.

180 (12) "Textbook" means the same as that term is defined in Section 53G-7-601.
