 146 access, use, disclose, or disseminate a record created or maintained by the division or any
 147 information contained in a record created or maintained by the division for a purpose
 148 prohibited or not permitted by statute, rule, regulation, or policy of a governmental entity.

149 (b) A person who discovers or becomes aware of any unauthorized use of records
