LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill enacts requirements for vaccination of dogs.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

► requires a person that sells a dog under the age of one year in a municipality or county to provide certification that the dog has received certain vaccinations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **10-8-65.6** is enacted to read:

26 (1) A person who sells a dog that is under the age of one year shall, at the time of sale,
27 provide to the buyer a certificate from a veterinarian that demonstrates that the dog has
28 received vaccination against:

- 29 (a) distemper;
- 30 (b) hepatitis or adenovirus;
- 31 (c) parainfluenza; and
- 32 (d) parvovirus.

33 (2) A person who sells a dog that is over the age of four months and under the age of
34 one year shall, at the time of sale, provide to the buyer a certificate from a veterinarian that
35 demonstrates that the dog has received a vaccination against rabies.

36 Section 2. Section **17-50-336.5** is enacted to read:

38 (1) A person who sells a dog that is under the age of one year shall, at the time of sale,
