Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **10-8-65.6** is enacted to read:

#### <u>10-8-65.6.</u> Vaccination requirements.

(1) A person who sells a dog that is under the age of one year shall, at the time of sale, provide to the buyer a certificate from a veterinarian that demonstrates that the dog has received <del>{a }</del>vaccination against<del>{ Parvovirus.</del>

<u>}:</u>

(a) distemper;

(b) hepatitis or adenovirus;

(c) parainfluenza; and

(d) parvovirus.

(2) A person who sells a dog that is over the age of four months and under the age of one year shall, at the time of sale, provide to the buyer a certificate from a veterinarian that demonstrates that the dog has received a vaccination against rabies.

Section 2. Section **17-50-336.5** is enacted to read:

### 17-50-336.5. Vaccination requirements.

(1) A person who sells a dog that is under the age of one year shall, at the time of sale, provide to the buyer a certificate from a veterinarian that demonstrates that the dog has received {a }vaccination against{ Parvovirus.}:

(a) distemper;

(b) hepatitis or adenovirus;

(c) parainfluenza; and

(d) parvovirus.

(2) A person who sells a dog that is over the age of four months and under the age of one year shall, at the time of sale, provide to the buyer a certificate from a veterinarian that demonstrates that the dog has received a vaccination against rabies.
