 - (c) parainfluenza; and
 - (d) parvovirus.
- (2) A person who sells a dog that is over the age of four months and under the age of one year shall, at the time of sale, provide to the buyer a certificate from a veterinarian that demonstrates that the dog has received a vaccination against rabies.

- (1) A person who sells a dog that is under the age of one year shall, at the time of sale, provide to the buyer a certificate from a veterinarian that demonstrates that the dog has received vaccination against:

- (d) parvovirus.
