Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **53E-6-205** is enacted to read:



53E-6-205. Professional educator licensure for military instructors.

The state board shall make rules under Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, to establish an expedited process for obtaining a professional educator license for an individual who has:

(1) a bachelor's degree;

(2) completed at least 160 hours of class time in a certified instructor course offered by the armed forces of the United States; and

(3) completed at least 300 hours of instruction as an instructor in the armed forces of the United States.
