
Representative Paul Ray proposes the following substitute bill:

6 7	LONG TITLE
8	General Description:
9	This bill amends provisions applicable to the Attorney General Crime and Violence
10	Prevention Fund.
11	Highlighted Provisions:
12	This bill:
13	 allows the Attorney General Crime and Violence Prevention Fund to receive
14	appropriations by the Legislature;
15	 modifies the activities for which fund money may be used;
16	 allows the attorney general to establish a volunteer task force to address the
17	activities for which fund money may be used;
18	 allows the attorney general to employ necessary support staff to administer the fund
19	and the activities of a task force established under this bill; and
20	 requires the attorney general to include information related to the activities of a task
21	force established under this bill in the attorney general's annual report to the
22	Legislature.

34	Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:
35	Section 1. Section 67-5-24 is amended to read:
36	67-5-24. Attorney General Crime and Violence Prevention Fund Use of money
37	Restrictions Volunteer task force Staff.
38	(1) There is created an expendable special revenue fund known as the Attorney General
39	Crime and Violence Prevention Fund.
40	(2) The fund shall consist of:
41	(a) appropriations by the Legislature; and
42	(b) gifts, grants, devises, donations, and bequests of real property, personal property, or
43	services, from any source[, made to the fund].
44	(3) (a) If the donor designates a specific purpose or use for [the] \underline{a} gift, grant, devise,
45	donation, or bequest provided under Subsection (2)(b), money from the fund shall be used
46	solely for that purpose.
47	(b) [Gifts, grants, devises, donations, and bequests not] <u>Unless</u> designated for a specific
48	purpose under Subsection (3)(a) [and that are], money in the fund not restricted to a specific
49	use under federal law[5] shall be used in connection with the activities under Subsection (4).
50	(c) The attorney general or the attorney general's designee shall authorize the
51	expenditure of fund money in accordance with this section.
52	(d) The money in the fund may not be used for administrative expenses of the Office of
53	the Attorney General normally provided for by legislative appropriation, except for the
54	purposes described in Subsection (8).
55 56	(4) Except as provided under Subsection (3), the fund money shall be used for any of the following activities:

57	(a) the Amber Alert program;
58	(b) prevention of crime against seniors;
59	(c) prevention of domestic violence and dating violence;
60	[(d) antidrug use programs;]
61	(d) programs designed to reduce the supply or demand of illicit or controlled
62	substances;
63	(e) preventing gangs and gang violence;
64	(f) Internet safety programs, including Internet literacy for parents;
65	(g) mentoring Utah partnerships;
66	(h) suicide prevention programs;
67	(i) underage [drinking] alcohol and substance misuse prevention programs;
68	(j) antipornography programs;
69	(k) victims assistance programs;
70	(l) identity theft investigations and prosecutions; or
71	(m) identity theft reporting system database.
72	(5) The state treasurer shall invest the money in the fund under Title 51, Chapter 7,
73	State Money Management Act, except that all interest or other earnings derived from the fund
74	money shall be deposited in the fund.
75	(6) The attorney general shall make an annual report to the Legislature regarding the
76	status of the fund, including:
77	(a) a report on the contributions received, expenditures made, and programs and
78	services funded[-]; and
79	(b) if the attorney general establishes a task force under Subsection (7), all activities
80	and programs initiated through the task force.
81	(7) The attorney general may establish a volunteer task force consisting of
82	representatives from public or private agencies or organizations in the state to address any of
83	the activities described in Subsection (4).
84	(8) The attorney general may employ necessary support staff to implement and
85	administer the fund and the activities of a task force established under Subsection (7).
86	Section 2. Appropriation.
87	The following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1,

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88	2020, and ending June 30, 2021. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for	<u>or</u>
89	fiscal year 2021. Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Proced	ures
90	Act, the Legislature appropriates the following sums of money from the funds or accounts	
91	indicated for the use and support of the government of the state of Utah.
