	Section 1. Section 41-26-109 is enacted to read:
	41-26-109. Unaccompanied minors in an autonomous transport.
	(1) As used in this section:
	(a) (i) "Autonomous transport" means a vehicle for hire operating in driverless
or	peration.
	(ii) "Autonomous transport" includes the following, if operating in driverless
or	peration:
	(A) a limousine as that term is defined in Section 32B-1-102;
	(B) a taxicab as that term is defined in Section 53-3-102;
	(C) a vehicle operated by a transportation network company as that term is defined in
Se	ection 13-51-102; or
	(D) a vehicle operated by a business offering a service similar to those described in
Sı	absections (1)(a)(ii)(A) through (C).
	(iii) "Autonomous transport" does not include a vehicle operated by a public transit
di	strict as defined in Section 17B-2a-802.
	(b) "Guardian" means a person who has qualified and been recognized by a court as a
gu	pardian of a minor court appointment.
	(c) "Parent" means a biological or adoptive parent.
	(d) "Safety belt" means the same as that term is defined in Section 41-6a-1802.
	(e) "Unaccompanied minor" means a person under the age of 18 that is not under the
su	pervision of an adult.
	(2) (a) An autonomous transport may not provide services to an unaccompanied minor
<u>th</u>	at is under the age of eight.
	(b) An autonomous transport may not provide services to an unaccompanied minor
ur	nder the age of 16 if the services are not requested and initiated by the minor's parent or
gı	uardian.
	(3) (a) Before an autonomous transport may provide services to an unaccompanied

57	minor under the age of 16, the autonomous transport shall ensure that a parent or guardian has:
58	(i) completed a waiver or permission form; and
59	(ii) provided emergency contact information for each minor being transported.
60	(b) The waiver or permission form may be part of the autonomous transport's mobile
61	application or other ride hailing technology.
62	(4) An autonomous transport shall ensure that any vehicle offered to provide services
63	to an unaccompanied minor:
64	(a) is enclosed with a roof or top;
65	(b) is equipped with functional safety belts;
66	(c) has current vehicle registration;
67	(d) is in clean and safe condition;
68	(e) maintains an interior temperature between 60 and 85 degrees Fahrenheit;
69	(f) is compliant with safety and equipment standards described in Chapter 6a, Part 16,
70	Vehicle Equipment;
71	(g) is equipped with an emergency communication system, including assistive
72	technology, that can establish effective communication between the vehicle, passenger, and
73	emergency services in the event of an incident; and
74	(h) has a video monitoring system to monitor activity in the vehicle, upload the video
75	data to a secure server, and retain the video data for the longer of:
76	(i) 90 days; or
77	(ii) a period of time for which the video data is needed for:
78	(A) evidentiary or investigative purposes; or
79	(B) pursuant to a warrant issued under the Utah Rules of Criminal Procedure or an
80	equivalent federal warrant.
81	(5) Before an autonomous transport may provide services to an unaccompanied minor,
82	the parent or guardian shall ensure that:
83	(a) the safety belt is properly fastened; and
84	(b) another parent or guardian, or another adult designated by the parent or guardian, is
85	at the destination to receive the unaccompanied minor.
