including differences in best practices based on the size, infrastructure, location, and other
relevant characteristics of a college or university; and
(xii) any other issue the board determines is relevant to the study;
(b) make recommendations for providing public safety services on institution campuses
statewide;
(c) produce a final report of the study described in this section, including the
recommendations described in Subsection (2)(b); and
(d) in accordance with Section 68-3-14, present the final report described in Subsection
(2)(c) to the Education Interim Committee and the Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice
Interim Committee at or before the committees' November 2021 meetings.
(3) In carrying out the board's duties under this section, the board \$→ [shall] may ←\$
coordinate with
individuals and organizations with knowledge, expertise, or experience related to the board's
duties under this section, including:
(a) the Utah System of Technical Colleges Board of Trustees;
(b) the Utah Department of Health;
(c) the Utah Office for Victims of Crime;
(d) the Utah Council on Victims of Crime;
(e) institutions;
(f) local law enforcement;
(g) local districts or special service districts that provide 911 and emergency dispatch
service; and
(h) community and other non-governmental organizations.
