LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill amends an existing program to create the Math and Science Opportunities for Students and Teachers Program.

Highlighted Provisions:

This bill:

- ▶ amends an existing program to create the Math and Science Opportunities for Students and Teachers (MOST) Program;
- ▶ amends the duties and authority of the State Board of Education related to the MOST Program;
- ▶ repeals requirements on the State Charter School Board related to the MOST Program; and
- ▶ makes technical and conforming changes.

Money Appropriated in this Bill:

This bill appropriates in fiscal year 2021:

- ▶ to the State Board of Education - Minimum School Program - Related to Basic School Programs, as an ongoing appropriation:
 - from the Education Fund, ~~⌚~~→ [\$4,700,000] \$900,000 ←~~⌚~~ ; and

182 (a) voluntary for an individual teacher; and

183 (b) voluntary for a charter school or school district.

184 Section 4. **Appropriation.**

185 The following sums of money are appropriated for the fiscal year beginning July 1,
186 2020, and ending June 30, 2021. These are additions to amounts previously appropriated for
187 fiscal year 2021. Under the terms and conditions of Title 63J, Chapter 1, Budgetary Procedures
188 Act, the Legislature appropriates the following sums of money from the funds or accounts
189 indicated for the use and support of the government of the state of Utah.
