28	(1) A person may not authorize or knowingly permit a motor vehicle owned by [him or
29	under his] the person or under the person's control to be driven by a person in violation of this
30	chapter.
31	(2) (a) A person may not rent a motor vehicle to another person unless the person who
32	will be the driver is licensed in this state, or in the case of a nonresident, licensed under the
33	laws of the state or country of his residence.
34	(b) A person may not rent a motor vehicle to another person until [he]:
35	(i) the person has inspected the license certificate of the person who will be the driver,
36	which may be done through electronic or digital means; and
37	(ii) verified the [signature on the] license certificate [by comparison with the signature
38	of the person who will be the driver written in his presence] is unexpired.
39	(c) A person renting a motor vehicle to another shall keep a record of the:
40	(i) registration number of the rented motor vehicle;
41	(ii) name and address of the person to whom the motor vehicle is rented;
42	(iii) number of the license certificate of the renter; and
43	(iv) [date and] place the license certificate was issued.
44	(d) The record is open to inspection by any peace officer or officer or employee of the
45	division.
46	(3) A person may not employ a person to drive a motor vehicle who is not licensed as
47	required under this chapter.

(4) A person who violates this section is guilty of an infraction.
