Mr. Speaker,

The Business and Labor Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 12**, ABUSIVE CONDUCT REPORTING AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. J. Stratton, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 6, Lines 171 through 179:*

- 171 (4) (a) The office may overturn the findings of the abusive conduct investigation if
172 the
173 office determines that:
174 (i) the findings are not reasonable, rational, or sufficiently supported by the
175 evidence;
176 or
177 (ii) the facts on which the findings are based are {unreliable or} inaccurate.
178 (b) The office may uphold the findings of the abusive conduct investigation if the
179 office determines that:
180 (i) the findings are reasonable, rational, and sufficiently supported by the evidence;
181 and
182 (ii) the facts on which the findings are based are {reliable and} accurate.
