Mr. Speaker,

The Political Subdivisions Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 61**, AMENDMENTS TO COUNTY FORM OF GOVERNMENT, by Representative L. Wilde, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 11, Line 316 through 324:
 - 316 (b) (i) [To be considered valid, the petition is required to be signed by registered voters
 - 317 residing in the county equal in number to at least 5% of the total number of votes cast in the
 - 318 county for all candidates for president of the United States at the most recent election at which
 - 319a president of the United States was elected]TheExcept as provided inSubsection (2)(b)(ii), thepetition is valid if the petition contains the
 - 320 <u>number of legal signatures required under Subsection 20A-7-501(2)</u>.
 (ii) For a county of the fifth or sixth class, the petition is valid if the petition contains at least the number of legal signatures equal to 30% of the number of active voters, as defined in Section 20A-7-501, in the county.

 - 322 <u>before the petition sponsors filed a notice of intent under Subsection (1)(a).</u>
 - 323 { (iv) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, an individual may not sign a petition
 - 324 <u>circulated under this section by electronic signature as defined in Section 20A-1-202.</u>
- 2. Page 24, Line 739 through 746:







- (1) In anticipation of an election under Section 17-52a-501, the county clerk [may]
- shall prepare a voter information pamphlet to inform the public of the proposed optional plan <u>in accordance with the provisions of Title 20A, Chapter 7, Part 7, Voter</u> Information Pamphlet .
- 741 (2) In preparing a voter information pamphlet under this section, the county clerk
- 742 [may] <u>shall</u>:
- (a) allow proponents and opponents of the proposed optional plan to provide written
- statements to be included in the pamphlet; and
- 745 (b) { use as a guideline the provisions of Title 20A, Chapter 7, Part 7, Voter Information
- 746 **Pamphlet** } <u>ensure each written statement described in Subsection (2)(a) is</u> printed in the same font style and point size .
