- 56 the students qualify for free or reduced lunch shall use an alternative breakfast service
model.
- 57 (iii) Beginning with the 2022-23 school year, a public school in which ~~{-50%~~
-} 30% or more of
- 58 the students qualify for free or reduced lunch shall use an alternative breakfast service
model.
