The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 145**, PHARMACY PRACTICE ACT AMENDMENTS, by Senator E. J. Vickers, with the following amendments:

1.	Page	10.	Line 29	l through	Page	11.	Line	308:
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- 291 Section 6. Section **58-17b-610.8** is enacted to read:
- 292 <u>58-17b-610.8.</u> Prescription devices.
- 293 { (1) A pharmacist or pharmacy intern may prescribe and dispense a prescription device
- 294 <u>described in Subsection (2) to a patient if:</u>
- 295 <u>(a) the patient has a current diagnosis, prescription, or treatment protocol</u> <u>from a</u>
- 296 <u>prescribing practitioner for which one or more of the devices described in Subsection (2) is</u>

- 307 <u>Board created in Section 58-68-201, to implement this section.</u>
 - (1) Any of the following documents from a prescribing practitioner shall be considered a prescription for purposes of the dispensing of and payment for a device described in Subsection (3), if the device is prescribed or indicated by the document and the document is on file with a pharmacy:
 - (a) a written prescription; or
 - (b) a written record of a patient's:
 - (i) current diagnosis; or
 - (ii) treatment protocol.
 - (2) A pharmacist or pharmacy intern at a pharmacy at which a document considered a prescription in Subsection (1) is on file may dispense a prescription device described in Subsection (3) to the patient in accordance with:
 - (a) the document; and
 - (b) rules made by the division under Subsection (4).
 - (3) This section applies to:
 - (a) nebulizers;
 - (b) spacers for use with nebulizers or inhalers; and
 - (c) <u>diabetic testing supplies.</u>
 - (4) The division shall make rules in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3,

Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, and in consultation with the board, the Physicians Licensing Board created in Section 58-67-201, and the Osteopathic Physician and Surgeon's Licensing Board created in Section 58-68-201, to implement this section.
