Mr. President,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 157, CHARITABLE PRESCRIPTION DRUG RECYCLING PROGRAM**, by Senator E. J. Vickers, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 3, Lines 64 through 73:*

- 64 (8) "Eligible pharmacy" means a pharmacy that:
65 (a) is registered by the division as eligible to participate in the program; and
(b) (i) is licensed in the state as a Class A retail pharmacy; or
66 {~~(b)~~} (ii) is operated by:
67 {~~(i)~~} (A) a county;
68 {~~(ii)~~} (B) a county health department;
69 {~~(iii)~~} (C) a pharmacy under contract with a county health department;
70 {~~(iv)~~} (D) the Department of Health, created in Section 26-1-4;
71 {~~(v)~~} (E) the Division of Substance Abuse and Mental Health, created in
Section
72 62A-15-103; or
73 {~~(vi)~~} (F) a charitable clinic.
