Mr. President,

The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 185**, CORRECTIONAL FACILITY TRANSPARENCY REQUIREMENTS, by Senator J. L. Anderegg, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 5, Lines 141 through 146:*

- 141 (u) (i) records that disclose a standard, regulation, policy, guideline, or rule
142 regarding
143 the operation of a correctional facility or the care and control of inmates committed to the
144 custody of a correctional facility; and
145 (ii) records that disclose the results of an audit or other inspection assessing a
146 correctional facility's compliance with a standard, regulation, policy, guideline, or rule
described in Subsection (3)(u)(i) **if:**
(A) before the records are disclosed, the correctional facility that is the
subject of the audit or other inspection is given the opportunity to respond to the
audit or other inspection in writing; and
(B) any response to the audit or other inspection provided by the correctional
facility is attached to a response to a request for records that disclose the results of
an audit or other inspection under Subsection (3)(u)(ii) .
