Mr. President,

The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 185**, CORRECTIONAL FACILITY TRANSPARENCY REQUIREMENTS, by Senator J. L. Anderegg, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 5, Lines 141 through 146:
 - (u) (i) records that disclose a standard, regulation, policy, guideline, or rule regarding
 - 142 <u>the operation of a correctional facility or the care and control of inmates committed to the</u>
 - custody of a correctional facility; and
 - (ii) records that disclose the results of an audit or other inspection assessing a
 - correctional facility's compliance with a standard, regulation, policy, guideline, or rule
 - described in Subsection (3)(u)(i) if:
 - (A) before the records are disclosed, the correctional facility that is the subject of the audit or other inspection is given the opportunity to respond to the audit or other inspection in writing; and
 - (B) any response to the audit or other inspection provided by the correctional facility is attached to a response to a request for records that disclose the results of an audit or other inspection under Subsection (3)(u)(ii)
