31 (a) the purchase of the ticket qualifies an individual to win the good, service, or

to benefit or provide support for a charitable purpose ~~{.}~~ ;  
**(c) the scheme for distribution does not involve a fringe gaming device, video**

**(d) the scheme for distribution does not seek to avoid application of or**  
**circumvent this part or Article VI, Section 27, of the Utah Constitution.**
