Representative **Keven J. Stratton** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 35 through 37:*

35 (a) Utah shall pursue adequate, reliable, affordable, sustainable, and clean water
36 resources, recognizing that Utah is ~~{the second most}~~ arid ~~{state}~~ and one of the driest states
in the nation and as such, there is,
37 and will continue to be, a need to ensure Utah's finite water resources are used beneficially;

2. *Page 4, Lines 100 through 103:*

100 (c) Utah supports the timely and appropriate negotiated settlement of federally reserved
101 water right claims for both Native American trust lands and other existing federal reservations,
102 and opposes any future ~~{reservations}~~ designation of public lands that ~~{result in~~
unquantified federal reservations
103 of water} does not quantify any associated federally reserved water rights .
