OUTDOOR ADVENTURE COMMISSION AMENDMENTS

Senator **David P. Hinkins** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 2, Lines 53 through 54:

53 (1) There is created the Outdoor Adventure Commission consisting of the following ~~{17}~~ 20  
54 members:

2. Page 3, Lines 61 through 78:

61 (e) the director of the Division of Parks and Recreation, or the director's designee;  
(f) the coordinator of the Off-Highway Vehicle and Recreational Trails Program in the Division of  
Parks and Recreation;  
62 ~~{(f)}~~ (g) the director of the School and Institutional Trust Lands Administration, or the  
63 director's designee;  
64 ~~{(g)}~~ (h) the executive director of the Department of Transportation, or the executive  
65 director's designee;  
66 ~~{(h)}~~ (i) two representatives of the Utah League of Cities and Towns appointed by the Utah  
67 League of Cities and Towns, one of which is a representative from an urban area and one of  
68 which is a representative from a rural area;  
69 ~~{(i)}~~ (j) two representatives of the Utah Association of Counties appointed by the Utah  
70 Association of Counties, one of which is a representative from an urban area and one of which  
71 is a representative from a rural area;  
72 ~~{(j)}~~ (k) a representative of the private sector appointed by the president of the Senate;  
73 ~~{(k)}~~ (l) a representative of the private sector appointed by the speaker of the House of  
74 Representatives;  
(m) a representative of the petroleum industry appointed jointly by the president of the Senate and  
the speaker of the House of Representatives;  
(n) a representative of the mining industry appointed jointly by the president of the Senate and the  
speaker of the House of Representatives;  
75 ~~{(l)}~~ (o) a representative of conservation interests appointed by the president of the Senate;  
76 and  
77 ~~{(m)}~~ (p) a representative of conservation interests appointed by the speaker of the House of  
78 Representatives.

3. Page 3, Lines 83 through 87:

83 (3) (a) If a vacancy occurs in the membership of the commission appointed under

84 Subsection (1)(a) or (b), or Subsections (1) ~~{(h)}~~ (i) through ~~{(m)}~~ (p) , the member shall be  
85 replaced in the  
86 same manner in which the original appointment was made.  
87 (b) A member appointed under Subsections (1) ~~{(h)}~~ (i) through ~~{(m)}~~ (p) serves  
88 until the  
89 member's successor is appointed and qualified.

4. *Page 4, Lines 88 through 89:*

88 (4) (a) ~~{A majority}~~ Eleven of the commission members constitutes a quorum.  
89 (b) The action of a majority of a quorum constitutes an action of the commission.
