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Representative **Jennifer Dailey-Provost** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 17, Line 501:*

501 (q) ~~{encourage}~~ require the development and use of cost-efficient renewable energy in  
project

2. *Page 17, Line 514:*

514 jurisdictional land with their boundaries with respect to the authority jurisdictional land; ~~{and}~~

3. *Page 17, Line 518:*

518 the long-term economic benefit to the state ~~{-}~~ ; and  
(d) require practices and measures designed to avoid or minimize negative environmental impacts  
of development and to provide the greatest protection to the environment, including the use of  
cost-efficient renewable energy.

4. *Page 18, Lines 525 through 527:*

525 (b) (i) In consultation with a municipality in which development is expected to occur, the  
526 authority shall establish minimum mitigation and environmental standards that a development  
527 is required to meet to qualify for the use of property tax differential.

(ii) The authority may not use property tax differential for development in a project area unless  
the minimum mitigation and environmental standards are followed with respect to that development.
