ABORTION REVISIONS

Representative **Steve Christiansen** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 8, Lines 224 through 230:

224 (a) the physician can demonstrate by a preponderance of the evidence that :

(i) the

225 physician reasonably believed that furnishing the information would have resulted in a severely

226 adverse effect on the physical [~~or mental~~] health of the pregnant woman; or

(ii)(A) a licensed mental health professional determined that furnishing the information would have resulted in a severely adverse effect on the mental health of the pregnant woman;

(B) the licensed mental health professional documented the determination described in Subsection (8)(a)(ii)(A); and

(C) the documentation described in Subsection (8)(a)(ii)(B) is retained in the pregnant woman's medical record;

227 (b) in the physician's professional judgment, the abortion was necessary to avert:

228 (i) the death of the woman on whom the abortion is performed; or

229 (ii) a serious risk of substantial and irreversible impairment of a major bodily function

230 of the woman on whom the abortion is performed;
