- 1. Page 10, Line 291 through Page 11, Line 308:
 - Section 6. Section 58-17b-610.8 is enacted to read:
 58-17b-610.8. Prescription devices.
 - 293 {<u>(1) A pharmacist or pharmacy intern may prescribe and dispense a prescription device</u>
 - 294 <u>described in Subsection (2) to a patient if:</u>
 - 295 <u>(a) the patient has a current diagnosis, prescription, or treatment protocol from a</u>
 - 296 <u>prescribing practitioner for which one or more of the devices described in Subsection (2) is</u>
 - 297 <u>indicated; and</u>
 - 298 (b) the pharmacist or pharmacy intern acts in accordance with rules made by the
 - 299 <u>division under Subsection (3).</u>
 - 300 <u>(2) This section applies to:</u>
 - 301 <u>(a) nebulizers;</u>
 - 302 (b) spacers for use with nebulizers or inhalers; and
 - 303 <u>(c) diabetic testing supplies.</u>
 - 304 <u>(3) The division shall make rules in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah</u>
 - 305 Administrative Rulemaking Act, and in consultation with the board, the Physicians Licensing
 - 306 <u>Board created in Section 58-67-201, and the Osteopathic Physician and Surgeon's Licensing</u>
 - 307 <u>Board created in Section 58-68-201, to implement this section.</u>}

(1) <u>Any of the following documents from a prescribing practitioner shall be considered a</u> prescription for purposes of the dispensing of and payment for a device described in Subsection (3), if the device is prescribed or indicated by the document and the document is on file with a pharmacy:

- (a) <u>a written prescription; or</u>
- (b) <u>a written record of a patient's:</u>
- (i) <u>current diagnosis; or</u>
- (ii) <u>treatment protocol.</u>
- (2) A pharmacist or pharmacy intern at a pharmacy at which a document considered a

prescription in Subsection (1) is on file may dispense a prescription device described in Subsection (3) to the patient in accordance with:

- (a) the document; and
- (b) rules made by the division under Subsection (4).
- (3) This section applies to:
- <u>(a)</u> <u>nebulizers;</u>

(b) spacers for use with nebulizers or inhalers; and

(c) diabetic testing supplies.

(4) <u>The division shall make rules in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah Administrative</u> <u>Rulemaking Act, and in consultation with the board, the Physicians Licensing Board created in Section</u> <u>58-67-201, and the Osteopathic Physician and Surgeon's Licensing Board created in Section 58-68-201,</u> <u>to implement this section.</u>
