| Section 1. Section 35A-4-403.5 is enacted to read:  |
| 35A-4-403.5. Waiver of one-week waiting period during emergency.                                  |
| For any week beginning on or after January 1, 2020, the department may waive the                  |

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| 30 | one-week waiting period described in Subsection 35A-4-403(1)(d) and pay a benefit to an           |
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| 31 | unemployed individual for that week if:   |
| 32 | (1) the unemployed individual otherwise qualifies for a benefit for that week; and                |
