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On motion of Senator Cullimore, **S.B. 3007**, CONTAGIOUS VIRUS PROVISIONS, was read the second time and circled.

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On motion of Senator Fillmore, the circle was removed from **S.B. 3006**, COVID-19 FINANCIAL RELIEF FUNDING, and it was before the Senate.

On motion of Senator Fillmore, the following substitute bill replaced the original bill:

1st Sub. S.B. 3006 COVID-19 Financial Relief Funding (L. Fillmore)

Senator Fillmore proposed the following amendment:

1. Page 5, Lines 131 through 142:

131 (1) "Business entity" means a business that:

132 (a) employs fewer than 100 employees;

- 133 (b) has the business's principal place of business in this state;
 134 (c) was in operation on February 15, 2020; and
 135 (d) (i) is properly registered with the Division of
Corporations and Commercial Code {– in
 136 accordance with Section 16–15–104–} :
 137 (ii) is tax exempt under Section 501(c)(3) or (19) of the Internal
Revenue Code;
 138 (iii) is a Tribal business concern described in 15 U.S.C. Sec.
657a (b)(2)(C); or
 139 (iv) is an individual who:
 140 (A) operates under a sole proprietorship;
 141 (B) operates as an independent contractor; or
 142 (C) is self-employed.

Senator Fillmore's motion to amend passed on a voice vote. Senators Sandall, Escamilla, and Vickers commented.
