31	Section 1. Section 67-19-12.6 is enacted to read:
32	67-19-12.6. State pay plans for DNR peace officers and wildland firefighters.
33	(1) As used in this section:
34	(a) "DNR peace officer" means an employee of the Department of Natural Resources
35	who is designated as a peace officer by law.
36	(b) "Wildland firefighter" means an employee of the Division of Forestry, Fire, and
37	State Lands who is:
38	(i) trained in firefighter techniques; and
39	(ii) assigned to a position of hazardous duty.
40	(2) The executive director shall:
41	(a) establish a specialized state pay plan for DNR peace officers and wildland
42	firefighters that:
43	(i) meets the requirements of Section 67-19-12;
44	(ii) distinguishes the salary range for each DNR peace officer and wildland firefighter
45	classification;
46	(iii) includes for each DNR peace officer and wildland firefighter classification:
47	(A) the minimum qualifications; and
48	(B) any training requirements; and
49	(iv) provides standards for:
50	(A) performance evaluation; and
51	(B) promotion; and
52	(b) include, in the plan described in Subsection 67-19-12(5), recommendations on

funding and salary increases for DNR peace officers and wildland firefighters.
