9                   **General Description:**

10                   This joint resolution of the Legislature approves acceptance by the state of Utah of  
11                   certain federal funds.

12                   **Highlighted Provisions:**

14                   ▶ approves acceptance by the state of Utah of all federal funds from Public Law  
15                   116-260, Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021.

19                   *Be it resolved by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

20                   WHEREAS, on December 27, 2020, following Congressional approval, the President  
21                   signed into law Public Law 116-260, Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021;

22                   WHEREAS, Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021 makes appropriations related to  
23                   COVID-19 emergency response and relief, including appropriations provided to the states  
24                   through certain federal agencies;

25                   WHEREAS, under Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2021, the state of Utah is to  
26                   receive this year federal funds in excess of \$10,000,000;

27                   WHEREAS, Section [63J-5-204](#) of the Utah Code requires that the Legislature approve  
28                   the state's receipt of new federal funds, if the state will receive total payments of \$10,000,000  
29                   or more per year from the federal government:

30           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of the state of Utah  
31 approves acceptance by the state of Utah of all new federal funds related to COVID-19  
32 emergency response and relief granted to the state of Utah under Public Law 116-260,
