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28	Section 1. Section 26-1-17.5 is amended to read:

30	(1) As used in this section, "immunization record" means the same as that term is
31	defined in Section 53G-9-301.
32	[(1)] (2) A record classified as confidential under this title shall remain confidential,
33	and be released according to the provisions of this title, notwithstanding Section 63G-2-310.
34	$\left[\frac{(2)}{(3)}\right]$ In addition to those persons granted access to a private record described in
35	Subsection 63G-2-302(1)(b), schools, school districts, and local and state health departments
36	and the state Department of Human Services may share an immunization record as defined in
37	Section 53G-9-301 or any other record relating to a vaccination or immunization as necessary:
38	(a) to ensure compliance with Title 53G, Chapter 8, Part 3, Physical Restraint of
39	Students[,]; and
40	(b) to prevent, investigate, and control the causes of epidemic, infectious,

49	(a) "Utah Statewide Immunization Information System" or "USIIS" means the vaccine
50	database operated by the department.
51	(b) "Vaccine information" means the relevant information, as determined by the
52	department by rule under Subsection (5), that a vaccine provider is required to report to USIIS.
53	(c) "Vaccine provider" means any of the following that provide vaccinations:
54	(i) a medical facility, as defined in Section 26-21-25;
55	(ii) a pharmacy, as defined in Section <u>58-17b-102;</u>
56	(iii) a local health department, as defined in Section 26A-1-102;
57	(iv) a school, as defined in Section 26-6-2;
58	(v) a physician's office; or

60	(2) A vaccine provider shall register with USIIS.
61	(3) (a) Except as described in subsection (3)(b), a vaccine provider shall regularly

64	vaccine provider shall comply with Title 53E, Chapter 9, Student Privacy and Data Protection,
65	and the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. Sec. 1232g.
66	(4) If a vaccine provider fails to report vaccine information under Subsection (3)(a) or
67	fails to provide adequate vaccine information, the department shall:
68	(a) inform the vaccine provider; and
69	(b) consult with the vaccine provider to assist the vaccine provider in becoming
70	compliant with this section.
71	(5) The department shall make rules in accordance with Title 63G, Chapter 3, Utah
72	Administrative Rulemaking Act, for determining:
73	(a) the relevant vaccine information a vaccine provider is required to report to USIIS;
74	(b) based on the amount of vaccines a vaccine provider delivers, how often a vaccine
75	provider shall report to USIIS; and
76	(c) the methods a vaccine provider may use to transmit the information.
