**LONG TITLE**

**General Description:**

This bill requires the Office of Recovery Services to report overdue support over \$10,000 in certain circumstances.

**Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:

- ▶ allows the attorney general and certain county and district attorneys to request information from the Office of Recovery Services concerning overdue support over \$10,000.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. Section **62A-11-334** is enacted to read:



26 **62A-11-334. Reporting past-due support for criminal prosecution.**

27 (1) (a) Upon request from an official described in Subsection (1)(b), the office shall  
28 report the name of an obligor who is over \$10,000 delinquent in the payment of support and the  
29 amount of overdue support owed by the obligor to an obligee.

30 (b) The following officials may request the information described in Subsection (1)(a):

31 (i) the attorney general;

32 (ii) a county attorney in whose jurisdiction the obligor's obligee resides; or

33 (iii) a district attorney in whose jurisdiction the obligor's obligee resides.

34 (2) The office shall make the report described in Subsection (1) no later than 30 days  
35 after the day on which the office receives the request for information.
