51	Part 2. Prohibitions
52	63G-27-201. Prohibition on contracting.
53	(1) Except as provided in Subsection (2), a public entity may not enter into a contract
54	with a company to acquire or dispose of a good or service, including supplies, information
55	technology, or construction services, unless:
56	(a) the contract includes a written certification that the company is not currently
57	engaged in a boycott of the State of Israel; and
58	(b) the company agrees not to engage in a boycott of the State of Israel for the duration

59	of the contract.
60	(2) This section does not apply $\hat{S} \rightarrow \underline{to} \leftarrow \hat{S}$ :
61	$\hat{S} \rightarrow [\underline{(a)}]$ if a company offers to provide a good or service under contract for at least 20% less
62	than any other company;
63	(b) to (a) $\leftarrow \hat{S}$ a contract with a total value of less than \$100,000; or
64	$\hat{S} \rightarrow I(e)$ to $I(b) \leftarrow \hat{S}$ a contract with a company that has fewer than 10 full-time employees.
