*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

#### Section 1. **Rules reauthorized.**

All rules of Utah state agencies are reauthorized except for the following:

~~(1) R614-1-5.F, General Provisions, Adoption and Extension of Established Federal Safety Standards and State of Utah General Safety Orders, Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), and~~

~~(2) the policy contained in Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control Policy Number 09-01, requiring store employees to check the identification of every customer.~~

#### Section 2. **Effective date.**

If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this bill takes effect on May 1, 2021.
