108	(i) order an alcoholic product from an approved vendor through the division; and
109	(ii) pick up an alcoholic product ordered as described in Subsection (1)(a)(i) from a

111	(b) requires an individual ordering an alcoholic product as described in Subsection

113	(i) designate a state store or package agency at which the individual would prefer to
