ENACTS:

76-6-1003.1, Utah Code Annotated 1953

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **76-6-1003.1** is enacted to read:

76-6-1003.1. Delivered package theft.

(1) As used in this section:



- 26 (a) "Dwelling" means the same as that term is defined in Section [76-6-201](#).
- 27 (b) (i) "Delivered package" means a package, parcel, envelope, or other item and its
28 contents that has been delivered to a dwelling by a delivery service, delivery person, common
29 mail carrier, or the United States Postal Service.
- 30 (ii) "Delivered package" includes mail as defined in Section [76-6-1001](#).
- 31 (2) An individual commits the crime of delivered package theft if the individual
32 knowingly, and with the intent to deprive another:
- 33 (a) takes, destroys, hides, or embezzles a delivered package from the porch, steps, or
34 the vicinity of any entrance or exit of a dwelling; or
- 35 (b) obtains by fraud or deception a delivered package from the porch, steps, or the
36 vicinity of any entrance or exit of a dwelling.
- 37 (3) Delivered package theft is a third degree felony.
