LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill enacts the Anti-Boycott Israel and Forced Uighur Labor Act.

- ▶ defines terms; and
- ▶ prohibits a government entity from contracting with a company:
 - that boycotts the State of Israel; or
 - for a good manufactured by the forced labor of the Uighur population.

27 Section 1. Section **63G-27-101** is enacted to read:

28 **CHAPTER 27. ANTI-BOYCOTT ISRAEL AND FORCED UIGHUR LABOR ACT**

29 **Part 1. General Provisions**

30 **63G-27-101. Title.**

31 This chapter is known as the "Anti-Boycott Israel and Forced Uighur Labor Act."

32 Section 2. Section **63G-27-102** is enacted to read:

33 **63G-27-102. Definitions.**

34 As used in this chapter:

35 (1) "Boycott action" means refusing to deal, terminating business activities, or limiting
36 commercial relations.

37 (2) "Boycott of the State of Israel" means engaging in a boycott action targeting:

38 (a) the State of Israel; and

39 (b) (i) companies or individuals doing business in or with the State of Israel; or

40 (ii) companies authorized by, licensed by, or organized under the laws of the State of
41 Israel to do business.

42 (3) (a) "Company" means a corporation, partnership, limited liability company, or
43 similar entity.

44 (b) "Company" includes any wholly-owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary,
45 parent company, or affiliate of an entity described in Subsection (3)(a).

46 (4) "Public entity" means the state or a political subdivision of the state, including each
47 department, division, office, board, commission, council, authority, or institution of the state or
48 a political subdivision of the state.

49 Section 3. Section **63G-27-201** is enacted to read:

50 **Part 2. Prohibitions**

51 **63G-27-201. Prohibition on contracting.**

52 (1) Except as provided in Subsection (2), a public entity may not enter into a contract
53 with a company to acquire or dispose of a good or service, including supplies, information
54 technology, or construction services, unless:

55 (a) the contract includes a written certification that:

56 (i) the company is not currently engaged in a boycott of the State of Israel; and

57 (ii) no good furnished to the public entity under the contract was manufactured in
58 whole or in part using the forced labor of the Uighur population; and

59 (b) the company agrees, for the duration of the contract, not to:

60 (i) engage in a boycott of the State of Israel; or

61 (ii) furnish to the public entity any good manufactured in whole or in part using the
62 forced labor of the Uighur population.

63 (2) This section does not apply to a contract with:

64 (a) a total value of less than \$100,000; or

65 (b) a company that has fewer than 10 full-time employees.
