30	fostering a business environment that attracts investment and creates jobs;
31	WHEREAS, expanded rail infrastructure can encourage individuals to travel by rail,

33	WHEREAS, the United States Congress, in 1982, enabled the formation of an interstate
34	rail compact between Louisiana, Mississippi, and contiguous states that led to the creation of
35	the Southern Rail Commission; and

45	this multi-state passenger rail commission and, more broadly, encourage the expansion of
