Mr. Speaker,

The Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Committee recommends **H.B. 154**, USE OF FORCE REVISIONS, by Representative K. Birkeland, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **3rd Sub. H.B. 154**, USE OF FORCE REVISIONS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 34 through 38:
  - 34 (i) the officer has probable cause to believe that the suspect has committed a felony

  - 36 (ii) the officer has probable cause to believe the suspect poses a threat of death or
  - 37 serious bodily injury to the officer or to [others] an individual other than the suspect if
  - 38 apprehension is delayed; or
- 2. Page 4, Line 106 through 110:
  - 106 (6) Once a criminal investigation is turned over from law enforcement, all
  - 107 <u>investigations into an officer's use of force shall be completed within 120 days</u> {<u>of the</u> <u>incident</u>
  - **108** <u>occurring.</u> <u>If an investigation is not completed within 120 days, the county or district attorney</u>
  - 109 <u>shall post a public statement on the county or district attorney's website stating a</u> <u>reasonable</u>
  - 110 estimate when the investigation will be complete and the reason for the delay.
