Mr. Speaker,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 233**, EDUCATION IMMUNIZATION MODIFICATIONS, by Representative M. A. Strong, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 39 through 41:
 - 39 (2) An institution that offers both remote and in-person learning options may not deny
 - 40 <u>a student who is exempt from a requirement to receive a vaccine under Subsection (1) to</u>
 - 41 participate in an in-person learning option based upon the student's vaccination status.
 - (3) Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply to a student studying in a medical setting at an institution of higher education.
 - (4) Nothing in this section restricts a state or local health department from acting under applicable law to contain the spread of an infectious disease.
- 2. *Page 3, Lines 78 through 80:*
 - 78 (ii) An institution that offers both remote and in-person learning options may not deny
 - a student who is exempt from a requirement to receive a vaccine under Subsection (1) to
 - 80 participate in an in-person learning option based upon the student's vaccination status.
 - (iii) Subsections (1) and (2) do not apply to a student studying in a medical setting at an institution of higher education.
 - <u>(iv) Nothing in this section restricts a state or local health department from acting under applicable law to contain the spread of an infectious disease.</u>
- 3. Page 5, Lines 127 through 129:

127 (5) An LEA that offers both remote and in-person learning options may not deny a

student who is exempt from a requirement to receive a vaccine under Subsection (1) to

participate in an in-person learning option based upon the student's vaccination status.

(6) Nothing in this section restricts a state or local health department from acting under applicable law to contain the spread of an infectious disease.
