Mr. Speaker,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 389**, MEDICAID RECOVERY AMENDMENTS, by Representative K. Birkeland, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 1, Lines 9 through 16:
  - 9 This bill addresses recovery of Medicaid funds from {-a parent whose child is injured in
  - 10 foster care } certain third party obligors .
  - 11 Highlighted Provisions:
  - 12 This bill:
  - 13 ► prohibits the Department of Health from recovering Medicaid funds from a {parent
  - 14 whose child suffers certain injuries in foster care if the foster parent a third party is obligated to
  - 15 pay for the injuries } third party obligor that is required to pay for injuries to a child in foster care ; and
  - 16 makes technical and conforming changes.

## 2. Page 3, Lines 59 through 64:

- 59 (c) The department may not recover medical assistance under Subsection (1)(a) if:
- 60 (i) the third party { is a foster parent who } is obligated to pay the recipient for an injury to
- 61 the recipient's child that occurred while the child was in the {<u>legal</u>} <u>physical</u> <u>custody of {the}</u>} <u>a</u> foster parent;
- 62 <u>and</u>
- 63 (ii) the child's injury is a physical or mental impairment that requires ongoing







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medical

64 attention, or limits activities of daily living, for at least one year.
