Mr. President,

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 97**, CHARITABLE PRESCRIPTION DRUG RECYCLING PROGRAM AMENDMENTS, by Senator E. J. Vickers, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 15:*

12 This bill:

13 ▶ allows an individual to transfer prescription drugs to an eligible pharmacy or an
14 eligible physician's office;

▶modifies the prescription drugs eligible for donation through the program;

15 ▶ removes the requirement that only state residents receive donated drugs; and

2. *Page 3, Lines 77 through 80:*

77 (9) "Eligible prescription drug" means a prescription drug, described in Section
78 58-17b-904, that is not:

79 (a) a controlled substance **, unless the drug is a long-acting depot injectable**
buprenorphine that is used for treating heroin addiction ; or

80 (b) a drug that can only be dispensed to a patient registered with the drug's
