Mr. President,

The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee recommends **S.B. 127**, HUMAN SERVICES PROGRAM AMENDMENTS, by Senator M. K. McKell, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. S.B. 127**, HUMAN SERVICES PROGRAM AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 14, Lines 413 through 417:
 - 413 (x) a procedure for [licensees to report incidents;] a licensee to:
 - (A) report the use of a restraint or seclusion within one business day after the day on which the use of the restraint or seclusion occurs; and
 - on which the <u>(A)</u> report a critical incident within one business day after the day
 - 415 <u>incident occurs</u>; { and
 - 416 <u>(B) provide a monthly report of all incidents during which the licensee used a restraint</u>
 - 417 <u>or seclusion;</u>
- 2. Page 16, Lines 473 through 475:
 - 473 (b) (i) The office shall enter and inspect a congregate care program at least once each
 - 474 <u>calendar quarter.</u>
 - (ii) At least two of the inspections described in Subsection (1)(b)(i) shall be unannounced.

 - 973 (a) when not otherwise prohibited by law, shall facilitate weekly confidential communication
