The Judiciary, Law Enforcement, and Criminal Justice Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 138**, VIOLENCE, DISORDER, AND LOOTING ENFORCEMENT PROTECTION ACT, by Senator D. P. Hinkins, with the following amendments:
