Senator Michael S. Kennedy proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Line 57 through Page 3, Line 69:
 - 57 (i) The special education student growth factor is calculated by comparing {S-3} S-2 total special education [ADM of two years] average daily membership of one year previous to the current year to the {S-3} S-2 total special education [ADM three] average daily membership two years previous to the current year, not to exceed the official October total school district or
 - 62 (ii) When calculating and applying the growth factor, a school district's S-3 total 63 special education ADM for a given year is limited to [12.18%] the following percentage of the
 - 64 school district's $\{ \frac{S-3}{S-2} \}$ total student ADM for the same year $[\frac{1}{S-2}]$:
 - 65 (A) for a school district in a county of the first, second, or third class, 14%; and
 - (B) for a school district in a county of the fourth, fifth, or sixth class, 20%.
 - 67 (iii) Growth ADMs are calculated by applying the growth factor to the {S-3-} S-2 total special education [ADM of two years] average daily membership of one year previous to the current
 - 69 year.
