Representative Carl R. Albrecht proposes the following amendments:

- 1. Page 2, Lines 36 through 40:
 - WHEREAS, although Utah's congressional delegation and <u>many</u> state and local leaders
 - publicly opposed the designation of the Bears Ears National Monument, in December 2016,
 - 38 President Obama designated the Bears Ears National Monument, limiting public access to 1.35
 - 39 million acres in San Juan County and affecting over 100,000 acres of land held by the School
 - 40 and Institutional Trust Lands Administration to which Utah should have a legal right to access;
- 2. *Page 2, Lines 48 through 49:*
 - 48 WHEREAS, <u>many people in rural Utah believe that</u> national monuments create a tourism economy that fails to offset the
 - 49 negative impacts of reduced natural resources related jobs;
