 - 48 shall notify the division within 30 days of the date of the opening of the investigation and
- 2. Page 5, Lines 122 through 126:
 - 122 (6) (a) A chief, sheriff, or administrative officer of a law enforcement agency who is
 - made aware of an allegation against a peace officer employed by that agency that involves
 - conduct in violation of Subsection (1) shall [investigate] conduct an administrative or internal
 - investigation into the allegation and report the findings of the investigation to the division if the
 - 126 allegation is { found to be true } <u>substantiated</u>.
