

**3rd Sub. S.B. 40**  
**STORAGE TANKS AMENDMENTS**

Representative **Keven J. Stratton** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 4, Lines 107 through 112:*

- 107           (2) "Aboveground petroleum storage tank" means a storage tank that is, by volume,  
108 less than 10% buried in the ground, including the pipes connected to the storage tank and:  
109           (a) (i) has attached underground piping; or  
110           (ii) rests directly on the ground;  
111           (b) contains regulated substances;  
112           (c) has the capacity to hold {~~351~~ 501 gallons or more; and

2. *Page 13, Lines 384 through 387:*

- 384           (b) (i) In addition to the fee under Subsection (1), an owner or operator of a petroleum  
385 storage tank who elects to demonstrate financial assurance through a mechanism other than the  
386 Environmental Assurance Program shall pay a processing fee established under Section  
387 63J-1-504.  
(ii) This Subsection (2)(b) does not apply to a self-insured public entity.
