1. Page 3, Lines 77 through 84:

- 77 (6) (a) A person with actual knowledge that [the] an advanced driver assistance [system]
- 78 <u>feature</u> of a motor vehicle is inoperable or has not been repaired or recalibrated [after a vehicle
- 79 glass repair or replacement as described in this section] may not knowingly sell, offer for sale,
- 80 or display for sale, the motor vehicle without providing written notice to the purchaser that:
- 81 {(a)} the advanced driver assistance [system] feature has not been repaired or recalibrated
- 82 to the manufacturer's specifications; or
 - **(ii)** the advanced driver assistance [system] feature is inoperable.

(b) This Subsection (6) does not apply to:

(i) a motor vehicle auction or a consignor to a motor vehicle auction, if no disclosure is required

under Section 41-1a-1005.3; or

(ii) a vehicle for which the ownership document is:

(A) a certificate of title in an insurance company's name;

(B) a salvage certificate, as defined in Section 41-1a-1001; or

(C) a nonrepairable certificate, as defined in Section 41-1a-1001.

84 [(7) A violation described in Subsections (1) through (6) is a civil penalty of \$500.]
